

The Otto Hahn Prize is jointly administered by the City of Frankfurt am Main, the Deutsche Physikalische Gesellschaft (German Physical Society) and the Gesellschaft Deutscher Chemiker (German Chemical Society). The prize is endowed with 50.000 Euro and a gold medal and is awarded every other year.

The prize promotes science by recognizing outstanding scientific achievements especially in the fields of chemistry, physics and applied engineering. One of the aims of the prize is to illustrate and promote the responsibility of science towards society as a whole.

In 2025 the prize should preferably honor an outstanding contribution in the field of physics. The prize will be awarded during a ceremony at the St. Paul's church (Paulskirche) in Frankfurt.
